Perry is a 42 year-old former Air Force Special Ops who was diagnosed with Diffused Large B Cell Lymphoma after returning from Kuwait and being exposed to chemical warfare. He is now in remission, but still has some issues with his diaphragm and is scheduled for additional surgery in the coming months. Perry is also a recovering alcoholic – now being sober for 8 years – and currently specializes in addiction counseling. We are honored to have Perry as part of our Americans family and his message to our team was quite humbling and inspirational. Our guys are looking forward to playing their best hockey for him this weekend and the remainder of the season.
